## From the Desk of the Pastor

Happy New Year! Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord, and we will have the Epiphany Proclamation at all our Masses with music. This is a tradition for today's feast, as a way of beginning the new year by announcing the dates of all the movable feasts throughout the coming year. We also have blessed chalk available in the Gallery for you to take home and mark your door frames, as we celebrate the arrival of the Magi.

Saint Joseph had reconstructive finger surgery! Well, at least artistically speaking. You may have noticed that our statue of St. Joseph, which moves to the Gallery during Advent and Christmas for the sake of the Nativity scene, was missing for most of Advent. This is because parishioner Larry Carstensen was repairing St. Joseph's finger and staff, which were badly in need of repair. The statue's right index finger had been smashed and cracked before I ever arrived at St. Patrick's, due in part to an earlier removal of the staff. Larry reconstructed and patched up the finger so that the staff can be easily removed in the future. Thank you, Larry, for your work on this project!

The statue of St. Joseph needed to be repaired because of an accident a number of years ago (probably by a friar!), but I did want to make an appeal to everyone, especially families with small children, about the need to be attentive in our parish facilities. Recently, the cross on the kneeler by the St. Patrick shrine was knocked off not once, but twice during Sunday Masses! On another occasion, a hymnal rack was pulled out of its place on the back of a pew. Additionally, I've had to permanently close off the coat room in Patrick Hall during coffee and donuts, because of small children running in there, and also playing in there unaccompanied. Parents have a great and noble task in raising their children in the faith and getting them to Sunday Mass. Saint Joseph is a particular model and intercessor for this, in his role as Head of the Holy Family and Protector of Jesus and Mary. This must be our incentive for being attentive to our children at all times, primarily for their safety and protection (lest they get hurt or lost in the shuffle of the Sunday crowd). We also want to be good stewards of our parish facilities, and make sure that they are not damaged or broken (then we'll need to find a good carpenter like St. Joseph to repair them!). Please make sure that your children are accompanied at all times, and if small children are headed for fragile or breakable things in the church or parish center, please stop them before it's too late.

On Thursday evening, the SEEK Conference opened at the Greater Columbus Convention Center. This is a gathering of over 20,000 college students and young adults, sponsored by

the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Held every year when college students are on winter break, the SEEK Conference has become a major event in the life of the Catholic Church in the United States. Because of our proximity to the Convention Center, a number of groups from across the country have been using our facilities this weekend for gatherings, meals, and special events. The priory is also at full capacity with a number of friars visiting from out of town, many of whom are involved in campus ministry. Pray for the success of the SEEK Conference, which is certainly an opportunity for many blessings and graces for our Diocese.

## BLESSED CHALK IS AVAILABLE IN THE GALLERY

### EPIPHANY CHALK BLESSING

The Church has a custom of blessing homes on the Feast of the Epiphany and the week following. Family and friends gather to ask God's blessing on their homes and those who live in or visit the home. It is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in our home, our comings and goings, our conversations, our work and play, and our joys and sorrows. A traditional way of doing this is to use chalk blessed during the Epiphany liturgy and write above the home's entryway, 20 + C + M + B + 26. The letters C, M, and B have two meanings. They are the initials of the traditional names of the three Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat*, "May Christ bless this house." The "+" signs represent the cross and 2026 is the year.

#### **Blessing of Chalk (if unblessed)**

V. Our help is in the name of the Lord:  
R. Who made heaven and earth.  
V. The Lord shall watch over your going out and your coming in:  
R. From this time forth for evermore.  
V. The Lord be with you.  
R. And with your spirit.

**Let us pray.** Loving God, bless this chalk which You have created, that it may be helpful to Your people; and grant that through the invocation of Your most Holy Name all who use it in faith to write upon the doors of their homes the names of Your saints, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, may receive health of body and protection of soul for all who dwell in or visit their home; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

#### **Instructions for Blessing the Home**

Using the blessed chalk, mark the lintel of your front door (or front porch step) as follows:  
**20 + C + M + B + 26** while saying:

*The three Wise Men, Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar followed the star of God's Son who became human two thousand twenty-six years ago. May Christ bless our home and remain with us throughout the new year. Amen.*

**Then offer the following prayer:**

*Visit, O blessed Lord, this home with the gladness of Your presence. Bless all who live or visit here with the gift of Your love; and grant that we may manifest Your love to each other and to all whose lives we touch. May we grow in grace and in the knowledge and love of You; guide, comfort, and strengthen us in peace, O Jesus Christ, now and forever. Amen.*

At times, God has commanded His people to mark their doors. The Israelites marked their doors with the lamb's blood on the night of the Passover. A similar command was given with the Shema Yisrael:

Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart...and write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates. (Deut. 6:4-6, 9)

"Chalking the door" is a way to celebrate and literally mark the occasion of the Epiphany and God's blessing of our lives and home. With time the chalk will fade. As it does, we let the meaning of the symbols written sink into the depths of our heart and be manifest in our words and actions.
