From the Desk of the Pastor

WOW! That's all I can say after the experience of SEEK26, right here in Columbus. Nearly 17,000 people gathered at the Greater Columbus Convention Center last weekend for the annual conference of the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). It was so uplifting to see many of our families and parishioners (and not just college students!) attending the conference. The priory welcomed a number of visiting friars, and many more friars were staying elsewhere, as they accompanied their various groups and ministries.

Most of the hotels and the southern building of the Convention Center lie within the parish boundaries of St. Patrick's, so our proximity to SEEK made us a popular place last weekend. Around 1,000 people came through our doors as part of special events that we hosted, from a Solemn Pontifical Mass for the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter, to holy hours for NET Ministries, the Thomistic Institute, and FOCUS. Several other groups used our halls for meals during the conference. A luncheon of FOCUS missionaries and students brought us visitors from Germany and Ireland. During one of our Sunday Masses, we had a group visiting from Australia. We truly got to experience the Universal Church during SEEK.

Speaking of Sunday Masses, even though Mass was celebrated at the conference, all of our weekend Masses had higher attendance because of the conference. Nearly 2,000 people attended Mass here last weekend. Like I said – WOW!

We had another connection to the SEEK Conference – our first class relic of St. Margaret of Castello was loaned to the conference, for veneration by participants in the Eucharistic adoration chapel. This allowed veneration and the story of Little Margaret to spread to thousands of people! Additionally, a providential visit to the parish on New Year's Day by two Franciscan Friars of the Eternal Word from EWTN led to an interview! I was invited to sit down with them for a recorded interview on the life of St. Margaret and our shrine, which will appear soon on EWTN's *Life on the Rock*. Stay tuned for broadcast details!

A great highlight from SEEK was the Saturday evening adoration, as nearly 16,000 people knelt down in Eucharistic adoration. I missed this though, because at the same time, I was one of over 300 priests in the next exhibit hall who was hearing confessions for nearly two hours. Sacramental graces were certainly flowing! As I processed out of the 10:30 a.m. Mass last Sunday, I could sense this overwhelming outpouring of grace on our diocese and our city because of SEEK. Let these graces continue to flow! And let us respond to what the Holy Spirit inspires in our lives. There

was more good news announced at the conference – SEEK will return to Columbus in 2027. Mark your calendars for SEEK27, which will be held at the Convention Center from January 1-5, 2027.
