From the Desk of the Pastor

What a snow storm! Last weekend was certainly something else, as we got so much snow. I left my retreat in Alabama early to get ahead of the storm, and thankfully made it back without any difficulty. Our March for Life group left Washington a little earlier than originally planned, and they got back to Columbus right before the heaviest snow started falling. I know that many people weren't able to make it to Mass last weekend, as the roads were terrible, and as your pastor, it's true to say that I missed you! Hopefully, your streets have been cleared, and that you were spared any accidents or loss of power. And I hope that the kids got to build a snowman or go sledding!

We are now winding down our observance of "long Christmas" with Monday's Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas). This will be the final weekend when all of our Christmas decorations will be up. If you're able to come on Monday evening, I encourage you to join us for our Candlemas celebration, which begins with the Blessing of Candles in Patrick Hall, and a procession into the Church. Please bring your own candles from home to be blessed (and you can purchase a pair of candles for your use at home before Mass, if you don't have any to bring). Candlemas is a rich celebration, as we proclaim the light of Christ in the midst of winter.

As the feast commemorates Jesus' presentation in the Temple 40 days after His birth, a consecration of the firstborn to God in the Old Law, it is also significant for those of us who are in religious vows. The Feast of the Presentation is also the World Day for Consecrated Life. We Dominican friars and sisters have all been consecrated to the Lord; we have made our life a total offering to Him! In the Dominican tradition, on Candlemas, we bring our candles up to the altar during the offertory of the Mass, signifying the total offering of our lives to God. As the candles burn, they are consumed, but not in vain – it is all done as a total offering to the Lord. We extend this practice to all those at the evening Mass, as the congregation is invited to bring their lighted candles forward. Though most in the congregation haven't been called to religious life, you have been baptized. And Baptism is itself an offering of our lives to God, as we put away the old life of sin, and embrace the new life of grace. When you bring your candle forward, it is a sign of your total offering to God in the Sacrament of Baptism. We live no longer for ourselves, but for Jesus Christ!

This weekend, the Women's Club and Women of Joy sponsored a Women's Morning of Reflection on Saturday. The morning included Mass, a potluck brunch, and Eucharistic

adoration (which included a talk, Rosary, and an opportunity for Confession). A special thanks to both groups for co-sponsoring this event (and for inviting me to be the speaker!). I encourage the women of the parish to get involved with these two ministries. On Saturday evening, our St. Patrick's Fellowship hosted a successful Trivia Night! Thanks to everyone who volunteered, and to our Fellowship leader, Amy McCoy, for organizing the event. A special thanks also goes out to the Knights of Columbus for overseeing concessions at Trivia Night. And the Knights aren't done: Next weekend, they'll be selling sub sandwiches after all Masses, and in two weeks, they'll be hosting the Chili Cookoff (on Saturday, February 14th). Finally, with the arrival of Lent in a few weeks, the Knights will be sponsoring our Friday Fish Fries. If you're a Catholic man 18 years or older, and want to grow deeper in your faith and to serve our parish and the local community, consider joining the Knights of Columbus Council 11207.

All of that food needs some sweets to go with it! Our American Heritage Girls will begin selling candy bars after all Masses starting this weekend (and continuing for the next two weekends). Please help out our troop with this important fundraiser. The American Heritage Girls are also hosting this weekend's Donut Sunday, so if you have a young girl in your family who may be interested in joining, be sure to talk to one of the members or leaders from our troop.

For one last time this season – Merry Christmas!


