From the Desk of the Pastor

Our Christmas decorations are down after our celebration of Candlemas, but we're only ten days away from the start of Lent. The liturgical seasons move along quickly, but our focus remains the same: Jesus Christ! He is the Savior of the world who was born in Bethlehem, who lived among us and taught us, and who went to the cross to die for us and rise to a new and glorious life. As we prepare for Lent, I invite you to bring your old blessed palms from home for our Palm Burning Ceremony next Sunday in the Parish Center Courtyard after the Noon Mass. These palms will be burned to make ashes for Ash Wednesday. When Lent begins, you will also notice unbleached altar candles (and this year, we'll have them at both the high altar and the altar of sacrifice). This is a traditional penitential practice for Lent (as well as Masses for the Dead), which highlights the sorrow and repentance of the season. It also serves as a great contrast to Easter, for when the Lord rises, we will light new bleached candles during the *Gloria* of the Easter Vigil.

While we still have over a week until Lent begins, this is a good time to start preparing for that season. Yes, it may be a time to enjoy our favorite treat one last time, but what is the Lord challenging you to do as this Lent unfolds? How could you pray more, especially through opportunities for Eucharistic adoration and devotions here at the parish? In what ways can fasting be more than simply "giving something up," but a means of sacrifice, and showing our reliance on God alone? What are ways that we can give alms beyond simply writing a check? It is my sincere desire to redevelop a service component to our Little Margaret's Charity, and I'm looking for ways to do this with our Pastoral Council. We also need volunteers who can give of their time for those who are in need.

The final month of winter can be hard to endure: we're past the joy of Christmas, and the salty streets and dreary skies may keep us a bit down. But notice what else is happening: the days are indeed getting longer. There really is more sunlight behind the clouds! This is what Jesus is doing all throughout our lives. Whether we are experiencing good or joyful moments, or if we are going through a rough patch, He is there all along! And the celebration of Lent, Holy Week, and Easter reminds us that He will always be victorious!


