On the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes (February 11th), Fr. Juan Macias celebrated the 7:00 a.m. Mass and spoke during a social for parishioners who work in the medical profession. It was a great morning, and a good opportunity for networking among those who care for the sick, with a friar who serves as a chaplain at both Riverside and Ohio State hospitals.

On the very same day, a new translation of *The Order of the Anointing of the Sick and of their Pastoral Care* went into effect. This will be the revised ritual and language for the celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, as well as the celebration of Viaticum (one's final Holy Communion), and the Apostolic Pardon (a plenary indulgence given at the moment of death). As the friars (and all priests, for that matter) learn to navigate this new ritual book, I wanted to give some reminders about the pastoral care of the sick at St. Patrick's:

#### **EMERGENCY PHONE**

One of the friars is always on call for medical emergencies requiring the sacraments for someone in danger of death. If there is a health scare, a hospitalization, or some other emergency, you should call the main church line: 614-224-9522. Wait for the recording, and when prompted, dial "8." This will connect you directly with the priest on duty. If he doesn't answer right away, leave a voicemail, and he will call you back soon after. I ask that you follow this procedure for medical emergencies instead of calling the secretary on duty, or even the friar's individual office number (since there is no guarantee he will be there or receive the call or answer a voicemail in a timely manner).

#### **REGULAR VISITS TO THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND**

If you're reaching a point that you are no longer able to come to Mass regularly, or if you know a parishioner who is homebound (but it is not an immediate emergency need), then you should reach out and let me know. We can arrange for a priest to visit you on a regular basis (usually every 4-6 weeks) for confession and anointing of the sick, and to bring Holy Communion, or we can arrange for an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (E.M.H.C.) to bring you the Eucharist on a weekly basis.

#### **ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

If you're experiencing a medical concern, it may be the time to receive the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. In decades past, when this sacrament was usually called Extreme Unction, it was often given at the point of death. While the theology of the sacrament is clear that it doesn't have to be given right at the point of death, on the other extreme, it was sometimes given out too freely, when there wasn't a real risk of death. This led to

some guidance from Bishop Fernandes a little more than a year ago. While the condition for receiving the sacrament is being in "danger of death," this does not mean the same thing as "point of death." For many people, age, previous health conditions, or the risk of a specific surgery may put them in "danger of death." If you are facing a serious health concern or risky surgery, please reach out to one of the parish priests, and you can discuss with him if it would be the right time for the sacrament, or if a blessing would be best. Since every individual's health concerns are different, yet also confidential, I recommend a good conversation with a priest in order to discern the best course of action for pastoral care. If a person is in declining health, please reach out sooner rather than later: It would be best to receive the sacrament earlier instead of waiting until a person's final hours (with the risk that a priest may not make it in time).

#### **HOLY COMMUNION FOR THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND**

A number of commissioned extraordinary ministers bring Holy Communion to the homebound on a regular basis. This is usually for those who are no longer able to come to church because of health, or who are temporarily homebound (because of recovery from surgery or childbirth, for example). These extraordinary ministers receive a two-year commission from the Bishop, and once the commission expires, it must be renewed for another two years. Recently, I've been approached by a number of parishioners who had previously been commissioned as extraordinary ministers, asking if they could bring Holy Communion to a family member at home (who is sick with a temporary illness, especially in cold and flu season). This is for a single instance, and not for regular visits. However, because their commission has expired, I cannot allow them to bring Holy Communion to the sick family member without first giving a special deputation (which any priest may do), but the deputation applies for that visit only.

If someone is sick at home for a single Sunday, and is requesting Holy Communion, we can arrange for an extraordinary minister to bring them Communion, since we have many who are commissioned. I would ask that this be arranged in advance, and not requested on Sunday morning, so that we have time to figure out the logistics for a visit. If it would be more convenient for a family member to bring Communion to a family member who is homebound or who may be recovering for a few weeks, I can request a two-year commission from the Bishop. However, I want to avoid granting single deputations on Sunday mornings, since deputations are really envisioned for emergency situations, and does not allow sufficient time for proper training.

On a final note, if anyone would be interested in being commissioned as an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion by the Bishop, and making yourself available to bring Holy Communion to sick and homebound parishioners on a regular basis, please contact me. We will be having a training in the next few months.

### What is Fasting and Abstinence?

Fasting is the limitation of food, allowing a person to eat one full meal and two smaller meals, with no solid food in between. The two smaller meals combined should not exceed the amount of the full meal. All Catholics ages 18-59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Abstinence prohibits the eating of meat (beast or fowl), though eggs, milk, and cheese are permitted. All Catholics from age 14 onward are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

### Easter Duty Obligation

Each of the faithful, after having received their first Holy Communion, is obliged to receive Holy Communion during the Easter season (Canon 920). This is traditionally linked to the requirement to confess grave sins at least once a year (Canon 989).

### St. Patrick Stations of the Cross

St. Patrick's offers Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent at 7:00 p.m., immediately following the Knights of Columbus Fish Fries.

### Eucharistic Adoration at St. Patrick's

St. Patrick's offers Eucharistic adoration every Tuesday from 12:15-8:00 p.m., a holy hour on Fridays from 12:15-1:15 p.m., and all-night adoration on the third and fourth Fridays of the month. Additional times for adoration will be scheduled during the parish mission and Holy Week.

### 40 Days of Adoration

The Diocese of Columbus sponsors *40 Days of Adoration* annually, in which every parish is asked to hold Eucharistic adoration on a day during the season of Lent. Our parish participation day will be February 27th and 28th.

### Confessions

In addition to regular confession times, each Wednesday evening of Lent, St. Patrick's will offer confessions in the Gallery Confessional:

- February 25 – 7:00 p.m.
- March 4 – 7:30 p.m. (after the Parish Mission)
- March 11, 18 and 25 – 7:00 p.m.
- April 1 – 7:30 p.m. (after Solemn Vespers)

There will be no confessions on Palm Sunday, Holy Saturday, or Easter Sunday.


