

Dominican Friars



We've reached June – the month of the Sacred Heart! And we need to reclaim that dedication for this month, and our belief in the love of God which is shown to us through the pierced heart of His Beloved Son. This month can be discouraging for Catholics, especially in recent years, as we see the true definition of marriage thrown aside, and ideologies forced upon us by the culture. Let us take comfort though in the words of our Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, in his recent address to diplomats, when he stated that civil societies "can be achieved above all by investing in the family, founded upon the stable union between a man and a woman" (Leo XIV, *Audience to Members of the Diplomatic Corps Accredited to the Holy See*, May 16, 2025).

In an effort to reclaim the month of June for the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we will have a new piece of religious artwork displayed in the sanctuary for veneration throughout June: a framed image of the Sacred Heart. This has been given to the parish by an anonymous donor who is devoted to the Sacred Heart, and just as we keep the statue of Our



Lady of Fatima in the sanctuary during the months of May and October, and a painting of the Last Judgment there during November, we will now begin the practice of placing the Sacred Heart image in our sanctuary for June. While the image will be displayed for veneration all month, it will be formally blessed before the 11:45 a.m. Mass on Friday, June 27th, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

This week, the friars will be away for a Provincial Assembly in Washington, D.C. (Father Paul Keller will be the lone friar staying behind, due to his work with the Bishop). He and a number of diocesan priests will be covering Masses and confessions while the rest of us are away. The Assembly is a good chance for the friars from all over the Province to reconnect, and this year, the Assembly will conclude with the ordination of seven brothers to the priesthood on Thursday,

June 5th. Please pray for us friars during this time away for meetings and fraternity with our fellow Dominicans.

Next Saturday, we will celebrate the Extended Pentecost Vigil at the 5:00 p.m. Mass. This Mass is a little longer than usual, with several Old Testament readings, similar to the Easter Vigil. It is a beautiful and moving liturgy as the Church awaits the coming of the Holy Spirit! There will also be the celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation for two adults at this Mass. If you've never been to this Vigil Mass before, I highly encourage you to come, as we all pray together: *Come, Holy Spirit!* God bless you,

DOMINICAN FRIARS AWAY FROM JUNE 2-5

The Dominican Friars will be away at a Provincial Assembly in Washington, D.C. for all the friars of the Province of St. Joseph from June 2nd-5th. All of our parish priests will be away, and the only friar remaining at St. Patrick is Fr. Paul J. Keller, O.P., due to his work at the Diocese. He and some visiting diocesan priests will be covering our regular parish weekday Masses during those days, as well as confessions. Thankfully, we will have two priests hearing confessions each day. If you are experiencing a medical emergency and need the sacrament of anointing of the sick, Fr. Paul Marich, O.P., our pastor, will have the emergency phone with him in Washington, and he will connect you with Fr. Mike Lumpe, the diocesan Vicar for Hospital Ministry. You should still follow the usual procedure of calling 614-224-9522, then dialing "8" when prompted, in the event of an emergency need for a priest.






