This weekend, we are happy to welcome Fr. Raphael Pio Akotha, O.P., to speak to the parish about the missionary work of the Dominican Province of St. Joseph in East Africa. Father Raphael Pio is assigned to our priory in Kisumu, Kenya, and we are blessed to have him visiting the parish. The faithful of St. Patrick's have always been generous in supporting our missions, and I trust that this year will be no different. Thank you in advance for your support.

Sunday is also our parish picnic, an enjoyable summer event that brings so many members of our parish family together. Once again, we will be meeting this year at Camp Mary Orton, and I encourage you all to come out and enjoy food, fellowship, and recreation. A special thanks goes out to our Pastoral Council, who oversaw the organization and planning of the picnic, and our Knights of Columbus Council #11207, who will be cooking at the grill! Thanks as well to everyone who stepped up to volunteer for the picnic – I am truly grateful!

Hopefully you had a chance to see Fr. Cornelius last weekend. Many parishioners remember him fondly from his time here last summer, and he moved into the priory on July 1st to become our new parochial vicar. He will be our parish Director of Evangelization, overseeing the O.C.I.A. program and adult catechesis and faith formation as his primary parish duties. We are grateful to have him back at St. Patrick's!

I'm also happy to announce the addition of a new member to our youth ministry team. Welcome Aidan Jackson, who was hired as a second assistant youth minister. Aidan is very enthusiastic to work with youth and will help Fr. Michael and Eddie Cotter with a number of tasks for our youth ministry program (especially coordination of outside events and communication and tech needs). Aidan will also be present on Tuesday evenings for high school youth group nights, as well as our junior high youth group nights.



I also wanted to share some unfortunate news with the parish. On Independence Day, we noticed that a statue of Our Lady of Fatima, which stood alongside the priory and faced the parking lot, was vandalized. This statue didn't necessarily stand out like the one at our Lourdes Grotto (especially since a number of flowers and bushes were growing around it), but hopefully you noticed it on your way into church. We're not sure if this was an act of malice against the Catholic Church, or the result of someone getting into trouble on the night of "Red, White, and BOOM!" Then this past Tuesday, the outdoor St. Patrick statue near the east entrance was knocked over in an act of vandalism. This incident was caught on our security cameras,



and as of publication time, we are working with authorities to find the culprit. Regardless of the circumstances of these acts of vandalism, they are quite unfortunate. I've been looking at ways to improve the fencing along the Naghten Street side of the church, and the open area by the priory that leads toward the Lourdes Grotto and the east entrance of the parish center, and now after these incidents, we should start looking at this project a bit more seriously. If you are interested in helping us repair or replace the statues, or want to know more about ideas for improving the fencing around the facilities, please let me know.

Mark Your Calendars... C.R.A.S.E. – CIVILIAN RESPONSE TO ACTIVE SHOOTER EVENTS FOR CITIZENS, BUSINESSES & ORGANIZATIONS Preparing for the Unthinkable!

St. Patrick Church and the Columbus Division of Police will be offering an important training session on **Civilian Response to Active Shooter Events** *(C.R.A.S.E.)* **Training** – Active Shooter Safety Planning on <u>Saturday, August 2, 2025, from</u> <u>12:00-3:30 p.m.</u> Active shooter training is essential to prepare you for the possibility of a violent attack. This training provides strategies and guidance for surviving an active shooter event, focusing on the "Avoid, Deny and Defend" strategy. It shows you how to recognize the warning signs of potential violence and react if an active shooter or violent individual enters the building. The parish staff and some parishioners have experienced this training and found it most valuable. Even if you have previously taken this training, there have been some significant updates, making a refresher session recommended.

All Ushers, Lectors, Hospitality, CCD Catechists and CCD Aides, Choir and Special Events Coordinators (i.e., Youth Group, American Heritage Girls, etc., and those who help out) are highly encouraged to attend.

This training session is open to all interested parishioners over the age of 16 years old. We ask that you make room in your schedule to accommodate this training session. The more aware we are of how to handle these potentially chaotic situations, the more help we can be in a crisis situation. As one of our staff said after attending the training, "I always thought I'd freeze if faced with an active shooter situation, now I have the knowledge on how to act and help others, too."
