What a glorious week we've had celebrating our Holy Father Dominic! On Monday evening, we were blessed to have a Solemn High Mass in the Dominican Rite for the traditional Feast of St. Dominic. Father Maximilian Jaskowak, O.P., who is Fr. Michael and Fr. Juan Macias' novitiate classmate (and my ordination classmate) was our visiting celebrant and preacher. On Friday, Fr. Stephen Dominic Hayes, O.P., the prior of the local Dominican community, celebrated the 11:45 a.m. Mass, which was the first part of the friars' day-long celebration of St. Dominic's feast day. The sisters also came to Mass and had their own celebrations later that day. This weekend also sees the dedication of the new St. Dominic shrine, occurring on Saturday, August 9th, the 140th anniversary of the Dominican friars' arrival at St. Patrick's.



In addition to the shrine, we have another new piece of furniture in the Gallery: our new Welcome and Hospitality Center. This project arose after the pedestal of the shrine was completed, as a way to complement the east half of the Gallery. Like the pedestal, the Center was designed by parishioner Daniel DeGreve, and built by craftsman Tim Sprosty. The Center will serve as an area for signups, novena cards, and other handouts. The sidewalls incorporate cork-board, to give us more bulletin board space in the parish center. The front of the Center has areas for pamphlets. During the week, the Center will be positioned flush against the wall, but on weekends, the Center will be wheeled out, with the middle wooden leaf/flap turned down, so that our hospitality volunteers can use it as a place to welcome parishioners and visitors, and to answer any questions. A highlight of the Center is a carving of the parish logo in the center. Thank you, Dan and Tim, for your fine work on this project.

This week, we also installed a memorial of the special visit of the relics of St. Thomas Aquinas. This memorial will be kept in Aquinas Hall as a permanent remembrance of that great weekend last December which drew 3,000 people to our parish. At the top of the memorial is the special linen cloth embroidered by Eunice Hayes, upon which the reliquary sat (the cloth is now a third class relic of St. Thomas). Opposite the linen cloth is a photograph



by Fr. Juan Macias of the veneration, with a commemorative plaque in the middle, which was designed by our office manager Patti Phillips. On each side of the plaque is the holy card that was designed by Larry and Winifred Carstensen, with the image painted by their daughter Bernadette Carstensen Cody. May many people look upon this memorial for years to come, and be uplifted by the prayers of St. Thomas Aquinas, who was once a visitor to our parish!

Our celebrations are not over yet! Next Sunday, August 17th, our Dominican Sisters will celebrate 100 years of their congregation's ministry in the United States. The Noon Mass will be celebrated by Fr. Michael Dosch, O.P., and the homilist will be Fr. Stash Dailey. These two priests, our former pastor and a son of the parish, were influential in bringing the sisters to the Diocese of Columbus and St. Patrick's in 2013. A reception will be held in Patrick Hall after Mass. On the following Sunday, August 24th, we will also honor Sr. Leonarda, also at the Noon Mass, as she prepares to leave for her new assignment in Illinois. A reception will follow that Mass as well.

As Sr. Leonarda leaves, we are also grateful to welcome Sr. Marta Gawron, O.P., our new Director of Religious Education, who arrived this past Tuesday. Welcome to St. Patrick's, Sr. Marta!

INFORMATION MEETING ON THE LOWERED AGE OF CONFIRMATION

Bishop Fernandes recently lowered the age of Confirmation to 9-10 years old, which is approximately the 4th Grade. In the spring of 2026, St. Patrick Church will have one large Confirmation class, with the 4th, 5th, and 6th Graders making their Confirmation together. This will allow us to catch up and implement the new policy in one academic year, and in future years, Confirmation will be celebrated in the 4th Grade. This change involves not only logistical changes, but also important catechesis for parents who have a child receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation next spring (as well as parents with younger children, who will have to prepare their children now to receive this sacrament at a younger age). Father Paul, Sister Leonarda, and Sister Marta invite all parents of Confirmation students (as well as any parent who wants to know more about the change) for an information session on Wednesday, August 20th at 7:00 p.m. in Patrick Hall. This will be a chance for some catechesis on the Sacrament of Confirmation and the Bishop's reason for lowering the age, and also some of the adjustments we are making to the C.C.D. program for the 2025-2026 school year. Refreshments will be provided.


