Last month, we were blessed to witness the canonization of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati, who was a lay Dominican in the early 20th century, and who has become a great patron for youth and young adults. He was canonized on the same day as St. Carlo Acutis, the first "millennial saint," whose feast day is actually this Sunday (and he was younger than me, which means he would have been under the age of 40 were he still alive today 😉 ). Saint Carlo is also a great saint for the youth, and his relics are buried in Assisi, the home of St. Francis. However, another blessed will be canonized by Pope Leo next weekend, and he too was a lay Dominican: Bartolo Longo. Some may know about him, but his canonization hasn't been getting as much press as the canonizations from September. Blessed Bartolo Longo's story is fascinating, as he was a Satanic priest who experienced a profound conversion, and worked tirelessly to promote the Rosary. He was responsible for re-building the ruins of a church in Pompeii, which has become an important shrine dedicated to the Rosary.

Because of the canonization of these two new Dominican saints, this calls for a celebration at our Dominican parish! I invite all of you to take part in our upcoming extended weekend in which we will celebrate the canonizations of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Bartolo Longo, while highlighting a number of ministries in the parish which have a connection to these saints. On Thursday, October 23rd, our Columbus Frassati Society will be hosting their monthly *Christ in the City* at 7:00 p.m, which includes adoration, confession, and a social in Aquinas Hall afterwards. All young adults ages 21-35 are welcome and encouraged to come, and celebrate the canonization of this group's patron saint.

Mark your calendars for Friday, October 24th, when we will have an all-parish celebration for these two newly canonized saints. The evening will begin at 5:30 p.m. with adoration and confessions. Then at 6:30 p.m., Bishop Earl Fernandes will be here to preside over Solemn Vespers and preach about these two new saints. Following Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, all are invited to a "Pizza and Potluck" celebration in Patrick Hall (both of these saints were Italian, so how can we go wrong with pizza!). We are requesting that parishioners bring in a side or dessert.

During the weekend, we are pleased to welcome Fr. Gabriel Torretta, O.P., as our visiting preacher. Father Gabriel is no stranger to St. Patrick's, as he was a transitional deacon here in the summer of 2014. Now he teaches theology at Providence College, and he has researched much on the lives of St. Pier Giorgio and St. Bartolo Longo, two saints to whom he is greatly devoted. He will give a special presentation on Saturday, October 25th at 10:00 a.m. in Aquinas Hall on the life of St. Bartolo Longo, which I hope will help our parishioners know a little more about this new saint. The presentation will be sponsored by our Rosary Confraternity. Father Gabriel will also preach at all Masses that weekend.

But wait, there's more! Our St. Patrick Youth Ministry will host Meatfest, their annual fundraiser, on Sunday, October 26th from 10:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. This year's Meatfest will be extra special, knowing that we have newly canonized saints who are interceding for our youth. Finally, the Lay Fraternities of St. Dominic will be hosting a toiletry drive all weekend, collecting items to be given in gift baskets to the poor. This is a way to put into action St. Pier Giorgio's great love for the poor and needy.

It will be a packed weekend to celebrate our new Dominican saints — and also to learn about some possible ministry and fellowship opportunities here at the parish. I encourage you to come to some or all of these events!

#### ST. GERARD MOTHER'S BLESSING October 18 and 19 After Every Mass





## 2026 PASTORAL COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

Prayerfully consider nominating yourself or a fellow parishioner to serve on the St. Patrick Church Pastoral Council. Nominees must be at least 19 years of age and permanently living in the greater Columbus area. Representatives on the Pastoral Council advise the pastor on important matters, facilitate communication between the pastor and parishioners, and sponsor several parish events throughout the year. In this Council, which is presided over by the pastor, "the Christian faithful, together with those who share in pastoral care by virtue of their office in the parish, assist in fostering pastoral activity" (*Code of Canon Law* 536.1). The Pastoral Council collaborates with the pastor to support the spiritual, social, and service goals of the parish. The Pastoral Council is strictly consultative in nature, and is regulated by the norms laid down by the diocesan bishop (*Code of Canon Law* 536.2).

One (1) position on Pastoral Council will be open for the upcoming year, 2026. This position will fill the vacancy of a councilor who is fulfilling her term.

Parishioners are invited to submit their own name or the name of another parishioner whom you feel would be a good candidate. (Before nominating someone, please ask for his or her permission.) All nominees must be registered members of St. Patrick Church. All nominees will be contacted to discuss the responsibilities and to answer questions.

There are no elections. With hopes for a significant number of nominations, the pastor will select the new councilor from among the nominees after prayerful deliberation, and consultation with the parochial vicars and the members of the nomination committee.

The council typically meets on the second Tuesday of the month (except July and August) from 7:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m. Members serve a three-year term, which may be renewed for a second consecutive term.




