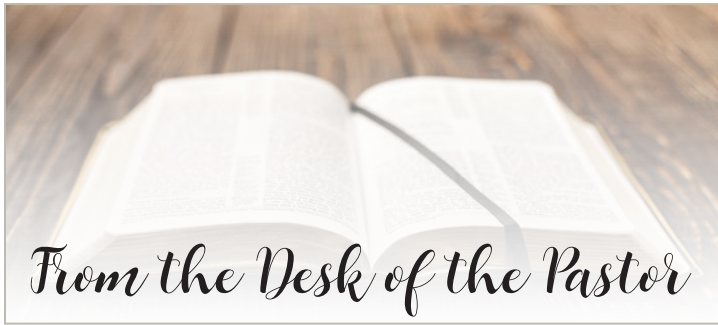

As we draw closer to the month of November, I want to draw your attention to two important things: our All Souls Novena of Masses, which will be celebrated from November 2nd-10th. Envelopes and Novena cards are now available at the Welcome Center in the Gallery. Please submit the names of your departed loved ones to be remembered at the altar each day of the Novena. Also in early November, we will have our All Saints Party, sponsored by the Knights of Columbus Council 11207, on Sunday, November 2nd at 11:30 a.m. in Patrick Hall. Children are invited to attend Mass and C.C.D. dressed as saints, in anticipation of the party! We look forward to seeing the creative costumes of our children as we celebrate the saints! Special thanks to the Knights of Columbus for organizing this, and also for their recent gift to the parish of a new American flag and Vatican flag for Aquinas Hall. Thank you, Knights!

This week is a long-awaited week: the start of the replacement of the parish center roof! After examining the repair needs, consulting with architects, contractors, and engineers, discussing the project with the parish finance council, and receiving bids for the project, we are ready to go (and the company started dropping off materials late last week). Please be patient in the coming weeks as the roof replacement takes place; hopefully it won't impede many of our activities or our access to the building. And thank you, the parishioners of St. Patrick's, for making this possible! In 2024, thanks to your generosity, we nearly doubled our parish goal for *The Appeal*. Every cent above our goal has come back to the parish as a rebate, which is being used to cover a substantial amount of the roof project. Thank you to all who contributed! And don't forget *The Appeal* 2025 if you have not made your pledge or donation yet. We are about \$24,000 shy of our goal. Once we reach that goal, the parish will be able to receive our rebate from the Diocese, free of the diocesan assessment (which is similar to a tax paid to the Diocese). Your generosity will help cover the costs of several capital projects in the parish, which will keep our building safe and looking beautiful for many more decades to come.

As we take part in *The Appeal* for 2025, we are looking forward to our anticipated rebate as a major source of funding for the new lighting project for the church. However, we have had some other capital repairs that needed to be addressed. Broken concrete on the front sidewalk of the church and the steps of the priory required concrete repairs, as well as repairs to the handrail for the priory steps. We also need to replace the outdoor church lighting, which helps to illuminate our facilities at night as a security measure.

Additionally, there has been talk for a while about replacing the bent and worn fence on Naghten Street. A few weeks ago, it got more tattered when a car accident resulted in major damage to the fence. But, I've been thinking about doing more than simply replacing what is there. A couple vandalism incidents over the summer, as well as the ongoing general security concerns in our present world, have made me see the importance of extending this fence along Kelly Alley and Mount Vernon Avenue, to protect the priory, East entrance by the Lourdes grotto, and the parish center. An access gate will provide a fitting welcome when the faithful arrive for Mass, while protecting the building when it is closed. I've received a number of inquiries about how parishioners can help strengthen our parish security. One way to help would be contributing to this new fence, which will keep our facilities safe (especially at night), and will serve as a deterrent to any unwanted characters who could be scoping out or lurking around the property. Please consider making a gift toward this new fence project.

Don't forget our parish celebration of the canonizations of St. Pier Giorgio Frassati and St. Bartolo Longo, with several events this week starting on Thursday! Come out and celebrate, especially on Friday evening with the Bishop!

2026 PASTORAL COUNCIL NOMINATIONS

Prayerfully consider nominating yourself or a fellow parishioner to serve on the St. Patrick Church Pastoral Council. Nominees must be at least 19 years of age and permanently living in the greater Columbus area. Representatives on the Pastoral Council advise the pastor on important matters, facilitate communication between the pastor and parishioners, and sponsor several parish events throughout the year. In this Council, which is presided over by the pastor, “the Christian faithful, together with those who share in pastoral care by virtue of their office in the parish, assist in fostering pastoral activity” (*Code of Canon Law* 536.1). The Pastoral Council collaborates with the pastor to support the spiritual, social, and service goals of the parish. The Pastoral Council is strictly consultative in nature, and is regulated by the norms laid down by the diocesan bishop (*Code of Canon Law* 536.2).

One (1) position on Pastoral Council will be open for the upcoming year, 2026. This position will fill the vacancy of a councilor who is fulfilling her term.

Parishioners are invited to submit their own name or the name of another parishioner whom you feel would be a good candidate. (Before nominating someone, please ask for his or her permission.) All nominees must be registered members of St. Patrick Church. All nominees will be contacted to discuss the responsibilities and to answer questions.

There are no elections. With hopes for a significant number of nominations, the pastor will select the new councilor from among the nominees after prayerful deliberation, and consultation with the parochial vicars and the members of the nomination committee.

The council typically meets on the second Tuesday of the month (except July and August) from 7:00 p.m.-8:30 p.m. Members serve a three-year term, which may be renewed for a second consecutive term.

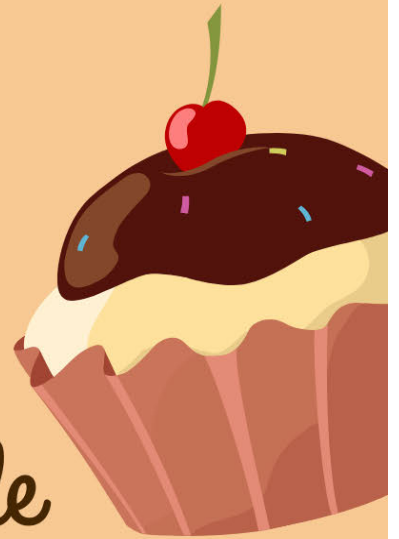

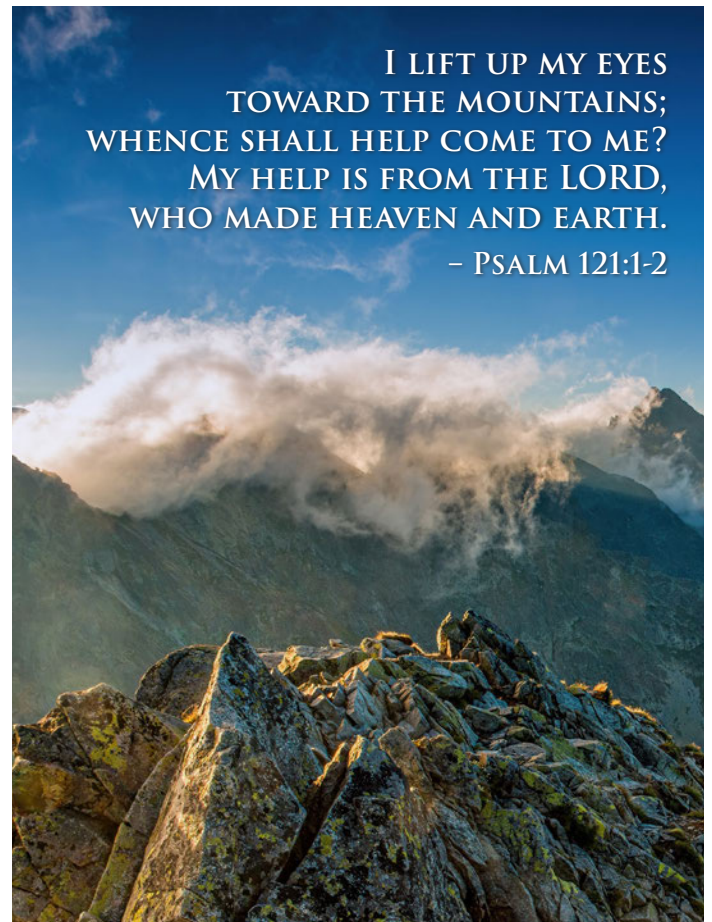
