Today's feast of the Dedication of the Basilica of St. John Lateran may seem a bit odd for a liturgical celebration, but this anniversary is so important, it takes the place of the 32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time. This is because the Lateran Basilica in Rome is the Pope's cathedral, the chief and mother Church of all Christendom. Many people may think that St. Peter's Basilica is the Pope's cathedral,



since he now resides at the Vatican, but for many centuries, he lived at the site of the Lateran Basilica, and it emerged as his primary church. During my pilgrimage to Rome in September with Patrick and Nancy Madrid, I was incredibly

blessed to celebrate Mass at the Lateran Basilica, and it was truly an awesome experience (see the photo above). After finishing the opening prayer of the Mass, I turned around, only to see the Pope's cathedra (his chair) right behind me! In that moment, it was a vivid reminder of the universality of the Church, and our communion with St. Peter, which continues in the person of his successor, Pope Leo XIV. Say a special prayer for the Pope today on this important feast day.

While the Church is universal, so often the work of the Church is done at the parish. We saw this last week, when the Knights of Columbus threw a wonderful All Saints Party for the children of the parish. It was so wonderful to see the kids dressed up as saints, and families had such a wonderful time. Thank you to our parish Knights of Columbus Council #11207 (and their wives!) for all their work in planning and organizing this wonderful event. The Knights are now collecting used religious books for their book sale next month, so be sure to bring in your donations.

The Knights are one of our many parish organizations that will be at the parish Ministry Fair next weekend. The Pastoral Council has been preparing for the fair for several weeks, and our ministry leaders have been preparing their booths and tables. Now they want to meet someone — you! Come to the Ministry Fair and find out how you can get involved and contribute to the work of the Church right here in our parish.

Over the month of October, our parishioners contributed to three service opportunities: baking cookies for the Kairos Prison Ministry, collecting spare change for Pregnancy Decision Health Centers, and donating canned yams and sweet potatoes for Catholic Social Services. Thank you to everyone for your kind generosity. This Sunday, which is November's Donut Sunday, we're pleased to welcome Kelley Henderson from Catholic Social Services. Be sure to meet Kelley between Masses and learn more about ways to serve throughout the Diocese.

We may not be building a new church to dedicate like the Lateran Basilica, but progress continues on the new roof of the parish center. New shingles have been laid over Patrick Hall and are moving toward the courtyard and classroom areas. The scaffolding that has been built near the East entrance of the parish center is for the work on the area above the kitchen and the priory roof. It will be great to see this project brought to completion.
