From the Desk of the Pastor

Over the last month and a half, we've seen scaffolding up and workers on site to replace our parish center roof, and also the roof of the priory. Everything looks great! The new shingles give a more historic look to our historic facility (even though the parish center is less than 25 years old). This also helps to protect our building for many more decades to come. I am grateful to our former pastor, Fr. Stephen Alcott, O.P., who oversaw the initial discussions of this project, our business manager, Frank Hartge, and our building superintendent, Matt Jivanjee, for their work in preparation and planning, and for the members of our finance council for their counsel and support (notably Mike Haemmerle and Dominic Boyden, who were part of the "roof team").

But the primary thanks goes to you, the parishioners of St. Patrick's, who made this project possible. We received a number of designated donations for the new roof project. However, many parishioners responded to this project by giving to *The Appeal*. This is the annual diocesan campaign to support a number of ministries, needs, and projects throughout the Diocese of Columbus. Every parish is given a goal to meet by the Diocese, but every dollar raised above that goal comes back to the parish (without the diocesan assessment tax), and the parish is free to use those funds for its own needs and projects. A year ago at this time, I addressed the parish about our roof project, and appealed to your generosity, asking you to help us meet our goal (and more!) for the sake of the roof. Your generosity showed, as we nearly doubled our goal! And now we can enjoy the fruits of your generosity, with a beautiful new roof.

As we approach Christmas and the end of the year, I'm coming to you again, asking you to remember *The Appeal* as part of your year-end giving, and to help with another major improvement project. Once again, every dollar raised above our goal comes back to St. Patrick's. As of this past week, we were still \$17,432.43 short of our diocesan goal of \$171,619.43. I'm confident that you will help us reach that goal soon, hopefully by the end of the calendar year. Once we reach our goal, all the funds that come back to the parish will be used for our church lighting project, which will replace the current lighting system (which dates to the church renovation in 2003) with new LED lighting. This is greatly needed, as the bulbs currently used in the church are no longer made, and eventually, the supply will be gone. This project will also allow us to improve the illumination of the artwork in the church, especially the murals above the side altars and on the ceiling, and the paintings of the Dominican saints. A team of parishioners (made up of architects, engineers,

and artists) have been helping design and implement this project. Now we just need to make sure we can pay for it!

If you have not made your pledge or a donation to *The Appeal* yet for 2025, you still have until April to do so (in fact, you may have already given earlier this calendar year, but it benefitted the 2024 campaign). Your support and generosity will help us reach our goal, but then also help us look to our own church improvements, like the new church lighting. I ask you prayerfully to consider what gift you may be able to give, especially as we prepare for Christmas, when we are in the habit of giving many gifts. This past week's Giving Tuesday doesn't have to be limited to one day; your gift to *The Appeal* today will have a great benefit for the diocesan church and also our parish church. I am grateful for whatever you can do to help!

SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE UPDATE

Our parish is blessed with many generous volunteers who help make our ministries, programs, and liturgies possible. As we continue our commitment to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all children and vulnerable persons, we are preparing for the Diocese of Columbus' updated Safe Environment requirements.

All volunteers are asked to be fully compliant with Protecting God's Children training and complete the required background checks by January 2, 2026. These steps help ensure that our parish remains a place of trust, protection, and faith for every member of our community.

Background Check Requirements

To meet diocesan policy, the following background checks are required for volunteers:

- **BCI (Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation) background check** – required for all volunteers
- **FBI background check** – in addition to BCI, FBI is required for volunteers who have lived outside the state of Ohio at any point in the past **five years**.

If you currently volunteer, or plan to volunteer in the future, we warmly encourage you to check that your VIRTUS account is active and up to date, and that your background checks have been completed within the required timeframes.

Please contact the Parish Office with any questions or for assistance completing your background check or VIRTUS requirements. Our staff is happy to help guide you through the process.

ADDITIONAL CONFESSION TIMES AND CONFESSORS BEFORE CHRISTMAS

For the season of Advent, the Wednesday evening confessions will be extended beyond the first Wednesday (December 3rd), with evening confessions on December 10th and 17th as well. Confessions will be heard in the handicap accessible Gallery Confessional, beginning at 7:00 p.m. until all are heard.

Beginning with the midday confessions on Thursday, December 18th, additional friars will be scheduled at all regularly scheduled confession times, in order to accommodate the anticipated number of penitents before Christmas.

On Tuesday, December 23rd, evening confessions will be heard starting at 7:00 p.m. until all are heard, during the final hour of Tuesday Eucharistic Adoration (Benediction will be celebrated at 8:00 p.m.). Confessions will be heard in the church until the line is finished, and this will be the last opportunity for confession before Christmas. There will be no confessions on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day.

On Sunday, December 7th, the 10:30 a.m. Mass will be celebrated *ad orientem* at the high altar, as will the 9:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, December 14th. This will be in addition to our regular celebration of the Noon Mass at the high altar, providing families who cannot attend the Noon Mass the opportunity to experience Mass celebrated "toward the East."




