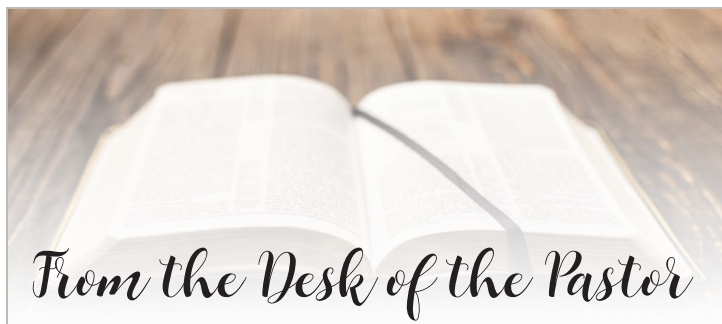

We enter the final days of Advent with great anticipation, for this week, we will celebrate the Birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ! At St. Patrick's, we await the arrival of our parishioners and visitors for our Christmas Masses. But before then, the friars will be busy in the confessional, hearing your final Advent confessions. This weekend, we will have extra confessors on hand between Masses, and on Monday and Tuesday of this week, we will have four priests available during the regular midday confessions. On Tuesday evening, there is a final opportunity for confession, starting at 7:00 p.m. during the regular Tuesday Eucharistic adoration. Don't miss these final chances before Christmas to receive the Lord's mercy in the Sacrament of Penance.

One of the highlights of the Advent season at St. Patrick's is our service of Lessons and Carols, always held on the evening of Gaudete Sunday. Every year at Lessons and Carols, I leave thinking "this was the best Lessons and Carols ever," as our choir is so good. And then we get to the next year, and that Lessons and Carols becomes the best one ever! 2025 was no exception. Our choir certainly outdid themselves this year, and they are to be commended. A special word of gratitude is in order for Kathleen Tully, our director of music, for leading our choir in such glorious music. Pray for our choir this week, that they will be healthy as they prepare to glorify God in song during the celebration of Christmas. Thank you as well to the Lay Fraternities of St. Dominic for hosting the reception after Lessons and Carols.

Our first ever observance of Bambinelli Sunday turned out to be a great success! Several parishioners, across all the generations of ages, brought the figurine of the Baby Jesus from their home nativity sets for a special blessing. We used a blessing composed by Pope Benedict XVI for this celebration in 2008. While the snow storm last weekend kept a number of parishioners homebound, my hope is that the Bambinelli Sunday blessing will become a new tradition in the parish for years to come.

The Knights of Columbus Council #11207 sponsored another successful Religious Book Sale during the first two weekends of December. This is a fundraiser to support the seminarians at the Josephinum. Hopefully you found some good books to read during these cold months of winter. Thank you to the Knights for hosting this event, which is an important way for our parish to support our local seminarians.

Over the last couple of months, I've been working with a number of our Pastoral Council members in selecting a new member for the Council. Deb Newman, who has served faithfully on Council for the last several years, will be going out of office at

the end of December, and the selection process began to choose a successor. After receiving nomination forms from parishioners (which you may remember seeing in the bulletin over the fall), the search process led me to select parishioner Sam Dean as the newest member of Pastoral Council. Sam joins a talented and committed group of 12 parishioners who advise me on matters related to the parish, and who oversee a number of parish events throughout the year (such as our St. Patrick Feast Day Celebration, the parish picnic, the Ministry Fair, and our church cleaning, which they recently sponsored on December 6th). Over the last few months, I've been working with the Pastoral Council to reorganize our standing committees, allowing us to refocus our efforts and service to the parish. The four new standing committees of Pastoral Council are: service, ministry, social, and outreach. This new structure will allow the Council to help me better implement my vision for St. Patrick's, especially in building up the community of the parish through different social events and reaching out to new parishioners. Thank you, Deb for your service on Council, and welcome Sam to Pastoral Council!

SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE UPDATE

Our parish is blessed with many generous volunteers who help make our ministries, programs, and liturgies possible. As we continue our commitment to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all children and vulnerable persons, we are preparing for the Diocese of Columbus' updated Safe Environment requirements.

All volunteers are asked to be fully compliant with Protecting God's Children training and complete the required background checks by January 2, 2026. These steps help ensure that our parish remains a place of trust, protection, and faith for every member of our community.

Background Check Requirements

To meet diocesan policy, the following background checks are required for volunteers:

- **BCI (Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation) background check** – required for all volunteers.
- **FBI background check** – in addition to BCI, FBI is required for volunteers who have lived outside the State of Ohio at any point in the past **five years**.

If you currently volunteer, or plan to volunteer in the future, we warmly encourage you to check that your VIRTUS account is active and up to date, and that your background checks have been completed within the required timeframes.

Please contact the parish office with any questions or for assistance completing your background check or VIRTUS requirements. Our staff is happy to help guide you through the process.

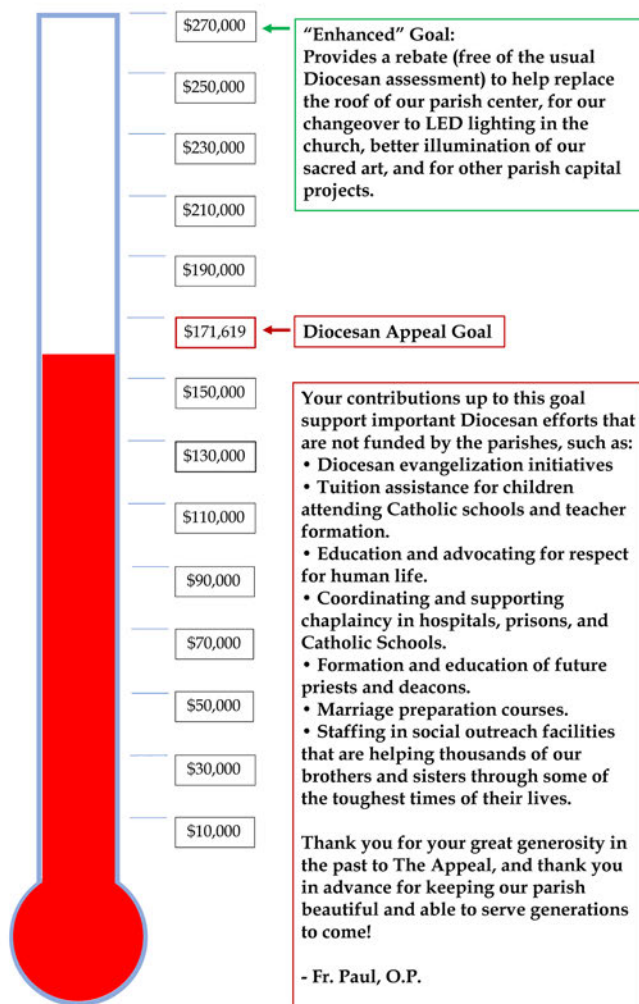

ARE YOU A REGISTERED MEMBER OF ST. PATRICK?

- Have you moved away from your parents' home?
- Are you newly married and starting your own family?
- Are you over the age of twenty-one and/or making contributions?
- Are you new to the area and just haven't gotten around to joining a parish, but love St. Patrick's?
- If you answered "yes" to any of the above, you may not actually be registered. Please stop by the Parish Office or visit our parish website to do so.

To avoid problems or misunderstandings, especially when planning Baptisms, Marriages, or other requests for the parish, etc., be sure that you are a registered and active member of the parish.

"WESHARE" THE PARISH'S ONLINE GIVING PLATFORM

Online giving helps ensure a reliable cash flow for the parish, allowing timely payment of expenses such as utilities and payroll, even when parishioners are away or unable to attend Mass for reasons of inclement weather or illness. WeShare, our online giving platform, allows you to make direct transfers from your bank account, or use debit/credit cards for your Sunday offering, as well as all Holy Day and special collections. Tightly integrated with our parish data management system, WeShare eliminates nearly all the parish's time-consuming tasks associated with the donation envelopes and bank bill pay: sorting and counting checks, preparing bank deposits, and manually entering each contribution. We are confident that you will find WeShare a convenient way to support St. Patrick's! It is easily accessible from the "Give" dropdown menu on the parish's web page at: www.stpatrickcolumbus.org. The system is also handy for paying fees such as CCD, Vacation Bible School, and more.

AUTOMATIC BILL PAY THROUGH YOUR BANK:

Many parish families use their bank's automatic bill pay service for making their weekly offering. When doing so, please be sure to use your "envelope/ID number" where the system asks for your account number.

IF YOU HAVE CHANGED YOUR STREET ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER, OR EMAIL ADDRESS:

Please inform the office so that we may update your records.

YOUR ENVELOPE ID NUMBER IS IMPORTANT!

Each parish family or single member is assigned an ID number, commonly referred to as your "envelope number." Whether you use the monthly envelopes, the parish's WeShare online donation system, or your bank's bill pay service, we must have your "envelope number" to properly identify your donation as coming from you. It helps us to compile an accurate year-end statement for your tax preparation, and also documents your support of the parish should you apply for the parish school tuition grant. **NOTE:** Checks placed in the collection basket at Mass must be in an envelope with your name written on the envelope, to ensure proper credit.

CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTION DEADLINE

The deadline for charitable contributions to Saint Patrick Church for the tax year is December 31st. Please be mindful that your year-end giving must be received by December 31st in order to be deposited and credited to St. Patrick's account for 2025. All donations received after December 31st will be included in the 2026 end-of-year statement. **SPECIAL NOTE FOR WESHARE USERS:** Processing your donation can take as long as seven days. **We recommend that WeShare donations be made by December 24th to ensure credit in 2025.**

GIVE SMARTER: SUPPORT ST. PATRICK CHURCH AND LOWER YOUR TAXES

You can use funds in your retirement account to support **St. Patrick Church**. The Charitable IRA Rollover allows donors who are 70 ½ years or older to transfer up to \$108,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation, which manages the **St. Patrick Vocations Youth Endowment Fund**. An endowment fund is a longer-term, sustained investment designed to provide a perpetual source of income to our parish. Regardless of your age, you can support **St. Patrick Church** while still qualifying for a tax deduction. Contributions to the **St. Patrick Vocations Youth Endowment Fund** can also be made in the form of cash, appreciated stocks, and other assets. 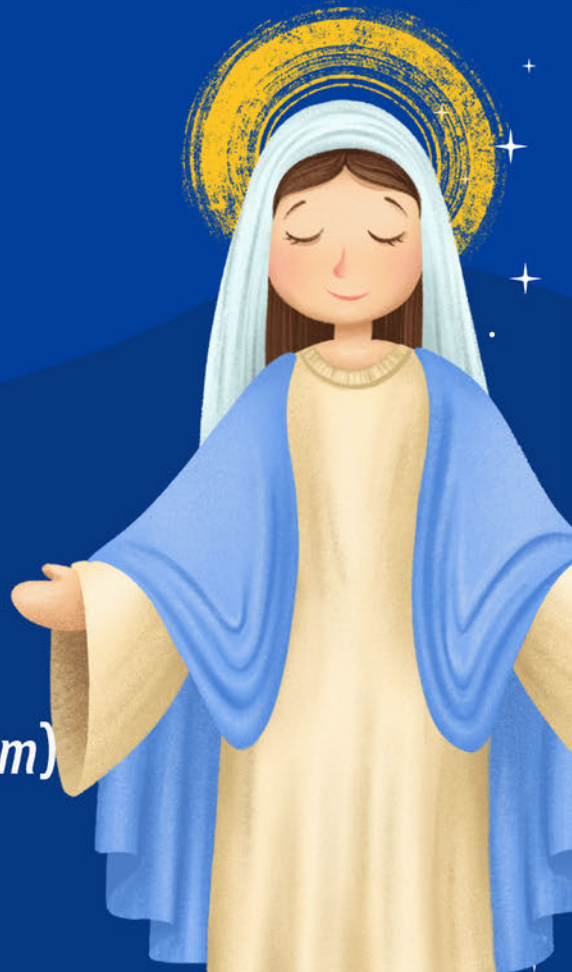
